

- Alexandria Zoo reserves the right to refuse access to a person or persons under the influence of excessive alcohol, or whose conduct is such as to make them objectionable to others or the safe operation of the Zoo.
- The Hosting Family has access to the Zoo for only the 15 min prior to their scheduled party time and then any remaining time after their party until the Zoo closes. All Birthday Guests must enter through Gate 13, unless arriving late and entering through the Main Gate, where they must check in.
- Children cannot be left alone in the zoo. Children are the responsibility of the Hosting Family, not the Alexandria Zoo.
- Alexandria Zoo shall not be responsible for loss of or damage to any property of the Hosting Family or Party Guests caused by theft, fire, accidental damages, or weather.
- The Hosting Family will be responsible for any damages accrued to Zoo property or facility by any other means than normal wear and tear.
- The Hosting Family may not assign or sublet to others the space and activities provided through this agreement.
- Children must be supervised at all times on the playground equipment, in the building and while walking in the Zoo.
- The playground is designed for ages 5-10.

For the safety and welfare of our animals and visitors, the following rules apply:

- **THE FOLLOWING IS PROHIBITED:**
 - Smoking, including the use of vape products, anywhere inside the Zoo
 - Firearms and weapons (even if you have a concealed carry endorsement). This includes items that appear to be weapons, including toy guns.
 - Alcoholic beverages and illicit drugs
 - Harassing the animals or intentionally harming an animal is prohibited. You will be escorted out of the zoo.
 - Dogs or other pets (Service animals are permitted.)
 - Drones or any similar remote-controlled vehicles/flying devices
 - Selfie sticks, loud noise makers and lasers
 - Picking the flowers or foliage, climbing trees, or disturbing the landscape so everyone has an opportunity to enjoy the many beautiful things growing throughout the Zoo.
 - Balloons, plastic straws, plastic lids, and glass containers
 - Skates, roller blades, skate boards, scooters, and bicycles
 - Distribution of any advertisement, circular or handbill, or solicitation of funds or pledges of contributions within Zoo property
 - Any other items deemed dangerous, suspicious, or inappropriate
- **ADDITIONAL RULES:**
 - All of our animals are on special diets. People food is not on their menu, so please do not share your food with them. Fish food can be purchased to feed the koi only.
 - Shirt and shoes are required.
 - Stay on the sidewalks and in designated public areas.
 - Do not sit children or other objects on railings, fences, or other barriers.
 - Do not hang objects over railings, fences, or other barriers.
 - The Zoo may take photographs of your party during your visit to the Zoo. These photos may be used by the Zoo for both internal and public publications, including the Zoo website and social media channels.
 - Student/commercial filming and photography must be approved by the Zoo in advance.
 - If someone is acting inappropriately or dangerously, they may be escorted from the Zoo. If you see someone acting in this manner, please contact a Zoo staff member immediately.
