# Summer Safari Counselor Description

#### General Summary

Summer Safari counselors will have the opportunity to gain experience in environmental and conservation education by utilizing the Zoo as an active, living classroom.

This is a seasonal position that runs from June through the end of June  $2^{nd}$ -  $27^{th}$  (with the potential for two more weeks in July) with a 20-25 hour per week commitment. Summer Safari children are divided into groups based on grade levels (K,  $1^{st}/2^{nd}$  Grade,  $3^{rd}/4^{th}$  Grade,  $5^{th}/6^{th}$  Grade). Each group has one teacher and one counselor. The teacher to student ratio is 1:20  $1^{st}$  grade and above and 1:15 for kindergarten.

This position requires a high level of enthusiasm and energy, creativity, flexibility, and the ability to work with groups of all ages in both in and outdoor settings.

### Primary Duties and Responsibilities

- Program facilitation and preparation: set-up and break-down of facilities and materials in assigned classrooms and other in-zoo sites used in camp programs.
- Assist Summer Safari teachers in daily instruction of weekly camp programs for ages 4-12.
- May have the opportunity of working closely with Education Curator in an administrative role.
- Abide by all Alexandria Zoo policies and procedures, including safety protocol and wearing appropriate Zoo uniform.
- Inform Education Curator or supervisor on duty if any emergencies arise.
- Assist with camper drop-off and pick-up.
- Other duties as assigned.

#### Qualifications

- Must be at least 16 years of age.
- Enjoy working with children and around animals.
- Good communication and leadership skills.
- Ability to lift 50 pounds and willing to work outside.
- Commitment of the entire Summer Safari term (6/2–6/27), 5 days/week (Monday through Friday) from 8:00 a.m. 12:30 p.m.
- Attendance at Summer Safari Orientation required; 5/29 1-4 pm.
- Able to work cooperatively with staff and volunteers.
- Interest and passion for conservation, biological diversity, conservation education, and the natural world.
- Candidates should be enthusiastic, creative, and self-motivated.

## **Work Environment**

Exposure to outdoor central Louisiana weather conditions such as heat, humidity, and rain will be required.

## Physical Demands

- Able to remain on feet and walk for extended periods of time.
- Frequently bend, stoop, reach, lift heavy objects, and climb.

#### Supervision

The position reports directly to the Education Curator.

#### Salary

Summer Safari counselors receive \$10 per hour.
