ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Washes dishes by hand, runs them through a sanitizer, dries and places dishes in proper storage space.
- Daily cleaning of preparation tables, refrigerators, food storage shelves and food bins.
- Daily sweeping and mopping of floors in kitchen and food storage room.
- Rotating produce boxes and placing newly arrived boxes in proper storage space.
- Maintain dry goods stock by cleaning and refilling storage bins as needed.
- Maintain meat cooler stock by cleaning meat trays, rotating stock and refilling trays on daily basis. Follows appropriate thawing guidelines for fish, meat, and whole prey items.
- Preparation of animal diets. Measures, cuts, weighs and counts items to obtain correct
 amounts of all individual diet items and supplements based on animal needs according
 to diet sheets prescribed by the animal management team. Required to handle raw
 meat, whole carcasses, fish and live insects.
- Care for feeder invertebrate colonies including meal worms, super worms, and crickets
